



1st YOUNG SOLOIST INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION

1. Pianists of all nationalities who are under 19 at the start of the competition and who are active participants of the Leonel Morales & Friends Masterclass may participate in the competition.
2. There will only be a grand winner and a unique award.
3. The winner must contemplate that he must be in the city of Granada on July 14, 15 and 16, 2022 for rehearsals and concert with the Orchestra of the University of Granada. If he could not be present or cannot attend for whatever reason, the prize as well as the opportunity to play with the Orchestra, with all the promotional and marketing benefits that this implies, will be awarded to the second best player of the competition.
4. The concert chosen by the candidate must be prepared entirely (with all the movements) and from memory for the competition.
5. The registration fee is non-refundable.
6. The participants will play in alphabetical order. The letter with which the competition will start will be designated by draw. This order may be modified by force majeure. The participant must justify it and the jury will take into account their reasons, taking a final decision. The draw will be held by the Organizing Committee of the competition and will communicate it to the registered participants as of June 15, 2022.
7. Acoustic Test. The participants may try the acoustic of the hall the day before the competition (7 July 2022). Contestants who are not present will not be able to try it. The acoustic test schedules will be sent on June 20, 2022.
8. The Jury may stop the performance of the contestant at any time without it meaning any kind of evaluation.
9. The Competition has managed special prices at the Alixares Hotel in Full Board Regime. Obtain all the information on our website, clicking on REGISTRATION> ACCOMODATION.
10. Study rooms. The Competition will have study pianos and a rehearsal with the accompanying pianist of 1 hour during the celebration of the competition.
11. The places for the competition are limited (maximum 10), and these will be accepted by strict order of registration.
12. All travel and visa costs will be responsibility of the participant. The requirements for obtaining a visa for Spain will be requested at the respective Embassy or Consulate. By previous request, the organization will send an invitation letter by e-mail.
13. The Artistic Direction of the Competition may solve all those situations not contemplated in these regulations. In case of a mistake in the translation of these regulations, the Spanish Form will be taken as official.
14. The enrollment in the Competition implies the acceptance of these rules in their entirety.
15. The competition reserves the right to authorize the broadcasting and telecasting of the concerts and rounds of the competition, as well as the right to record on any musical or video support in favor of the competition.
